## Air Officials to Release Regulatory Alternatives to EPA's NSR Rules

Deeply concerned that EPA rules issued last year to "reform" the New Source Review program will diminish air quality protections, state and local air officials have taken action to avail themselves of their statutory right to implement their own programs. Facilitated by the State and Territorial Air Pollution Program Administrators and the Association of Local Air Pollution Control Officials, air regulators have developed a comprehensive "menu" of alternatives to EPA's NSR reforms for use by state and local agencies that wish to adopt or retain NSR rules that differ from the federal rules.
