LADCO's Training Role



- Purpose Statement: “to organize and coordinate training for its member states” (LADCO By-Laws, Article III)
- LADCO-sponsored training is intended to supplement State training

- Training Grants
 - FY00 (\$20K)
 - FY01 (\$35K)
 - FY02 (\$53.2K)
 - FY03 (\$53.3K + \$12K)
 - FY04 (\$100 K + \$25K)
 - FY05 (\$70K)
- Other Training
 - LADCO, RPO, Air Toxics Grants

- FY01: 9 specialized technical classes (modeling, emissions)
- FY02: 4 VOC control classes (R. Joseph)
