

Academy As More Than A Host



- Surveys and Director interviews lead to course offerings
- NESCAUM Technical Committee briefings lead to course offerings
- Course evaluations lead to course updates
- Purchasing alternative courses when necessary
- Developing courses when necessary
- Records Management/Training History
- Travel subsidies one of strongest aspects of program

Ongoing Projects/Activities



- Continued need for introductory AND advanced courses needed due to state budget cuts and reprogramming of state staff
- Mobile source advanced modules being developed. Motor Vehicle Fuels Diesel Engine Technology Diesel Engine Emission Testing Tentative roll-out date is September (pilot).
