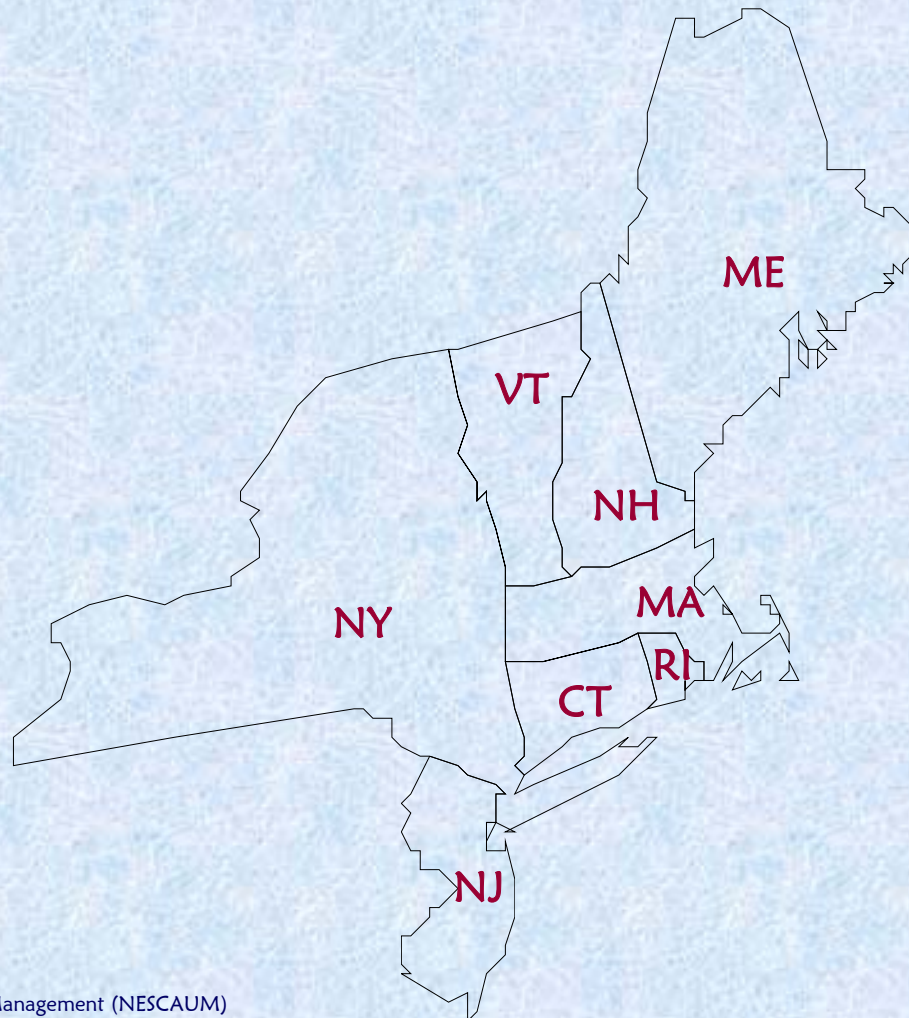

Ongoing Projects/Activities

- Continued need for introductory AND advanced courses needed due to state budget cuts and reprogramming of state staff
- Mobile source advanced modules being developed.
 - Motor Vehicle Fuels
 - Diesel Engine Technology
 - Diesel Engine Emission TestingTentative roll-out date is September (pilot).
