House-Senate Omnibus Riders for FY 2023

- prohibition of funds for rules that require Title V permits for carbon dioxide, nitrous oxide, water vapor, or methane emissions.
- prohibition on EPA using funds to implement any rule provision requiring mandatory reporting of greenhouse gas emissions from manure management systems
