Mary,

Per our conversation, here is some specific information on the portions of CAIR that have emission reporting requirements. There are substantive changes to the CERR in these sections and I'm sure that your members will be interested. Unfortunately, we will not be available for your regular conference call on June 1. However, we can participate in a special call later next week if you would like. Please let me know and I'll coordinate at our end. Here are some specifics on where to look in the overall CAIR package:

Would you please send e-mail to the RO EI contact list drawing their attention to the Clean Air Interstate Rule SNPR that was signed on May 18, which is posted at

http://www.epa.gov/interstateairquality/rule.html

. Point out to them that Section III.B of the preamble addresses proposed changes in emissions reporting, some of which would affect all 50 states not just those covered by the CAIR proposal. Also, point to the proposed rule text affecting 40 CRF 51. Also, say that we expect that by May 27 there will be a Technical Support Document on Emissions Reporting posted at this website also, which will help readers understand what aspects of the CERR are proposed for change and how individual states would be affected. Ask the RO staff to make sure that state EI staff and managers are aware of this proposal, and understand the hearing plan and comment period deadline.
